With the new Cache Creek Nature Preserve Visitor Center as the trailhead and gathering space, this project will create a trail system to connect Cache Creek properties owned by Yolo County to provide regional recreation and outdoor education opportunities consistent with the Cache Creek Parkway Plan, as well as showcase environmental and agricultural resources. An initial proposed trail map for a portion of Phase 1 trail construction is demonstrated above.
