ABOUT THE VISITOR CENTER

Yolo County, in partnership with the Cache Creek Conservancy, is proposing to build a new visitor center at the Cache Creek Nature Preserve to enhance experiential learning opportunities for local school children and the public. In addition, the County is seeking to extend existing trails along Cache Creek. The County is working with architects to develop a draft design for the visitor center, which could include exhibit space, expansion of event space, better utilization of the working barn, interactive displays, and specific areas to feature local Native American heritage.
